## EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

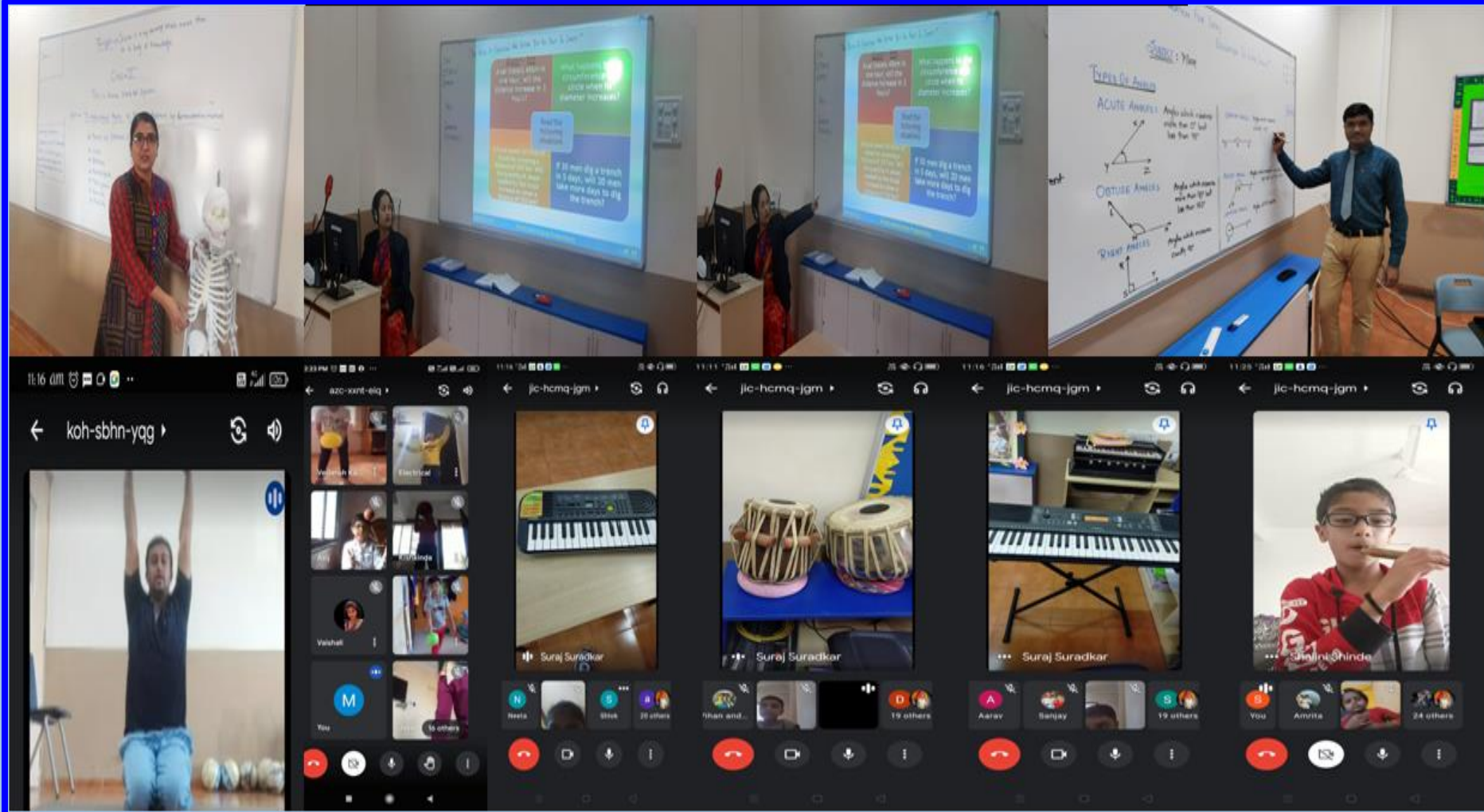

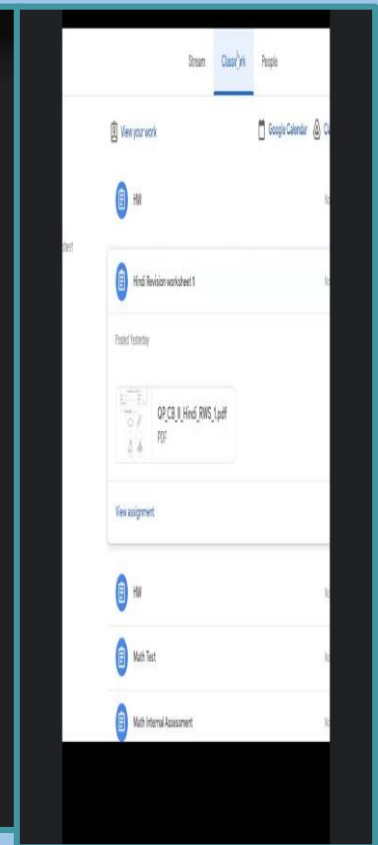
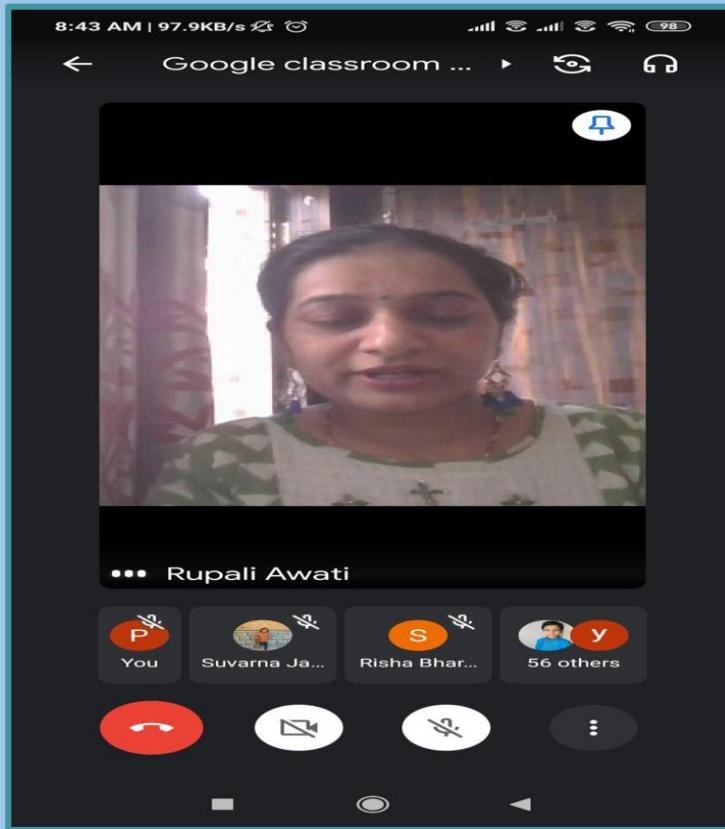
# Orientation for new academic year 2021-22



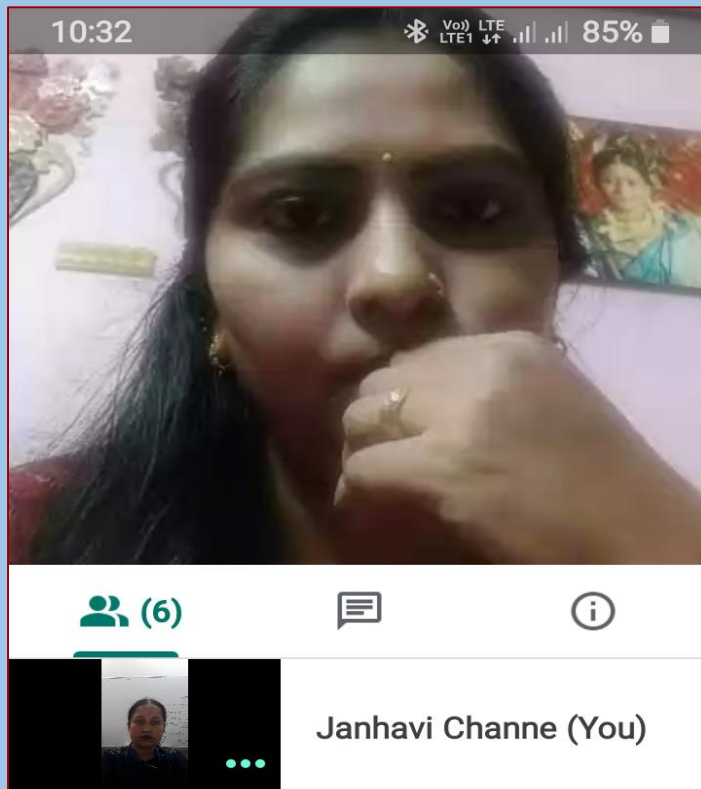

# Formation of Parent Teacher Association



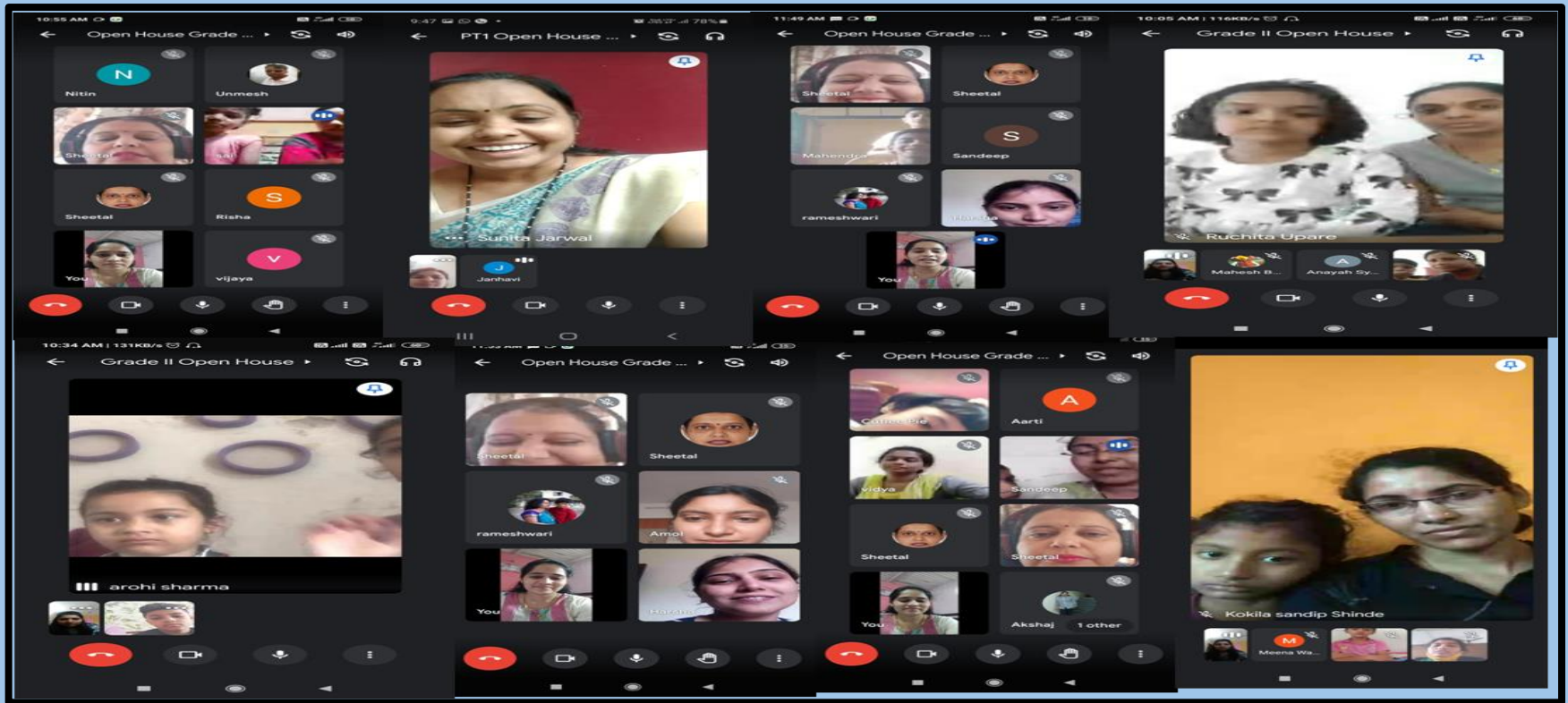

# Sports Activities - PT Drill



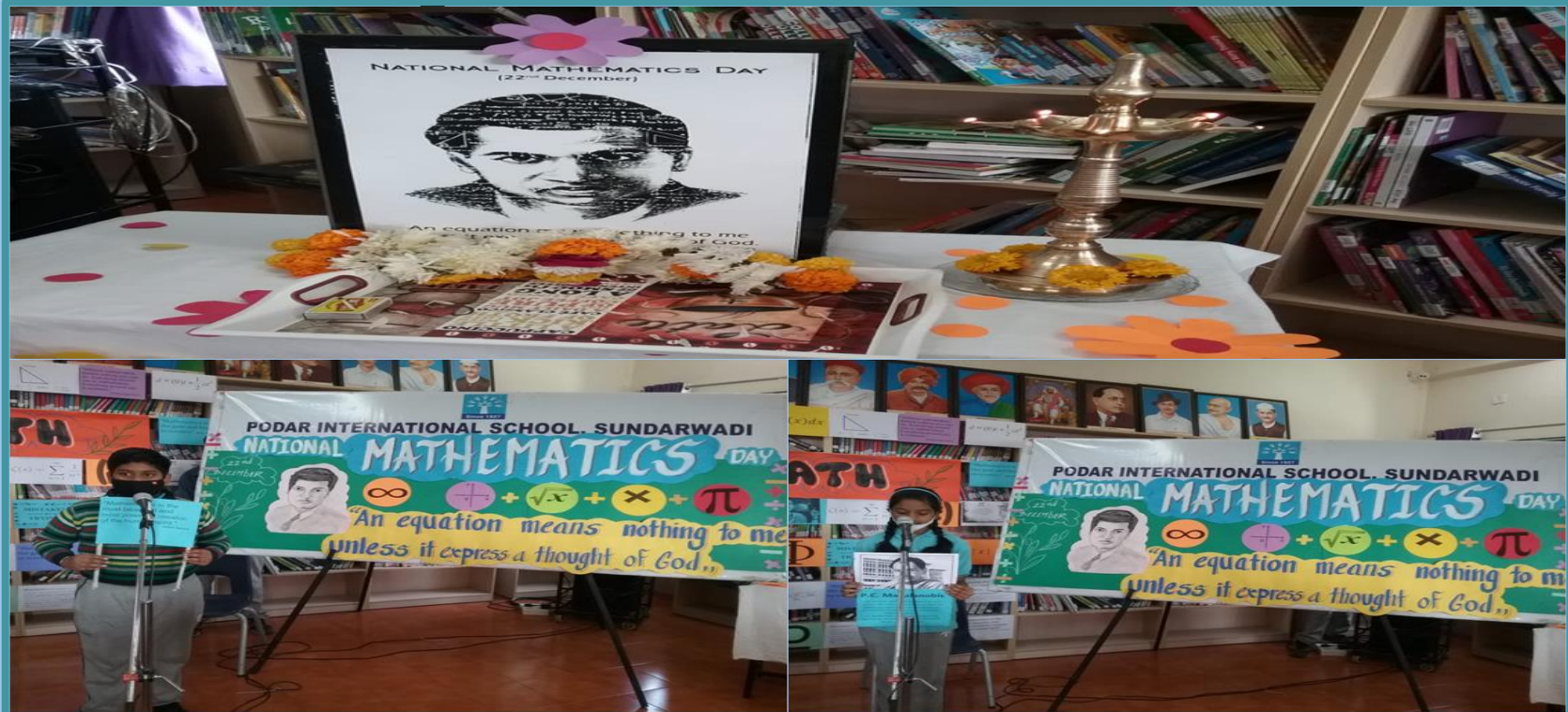

# Independence day Celebration



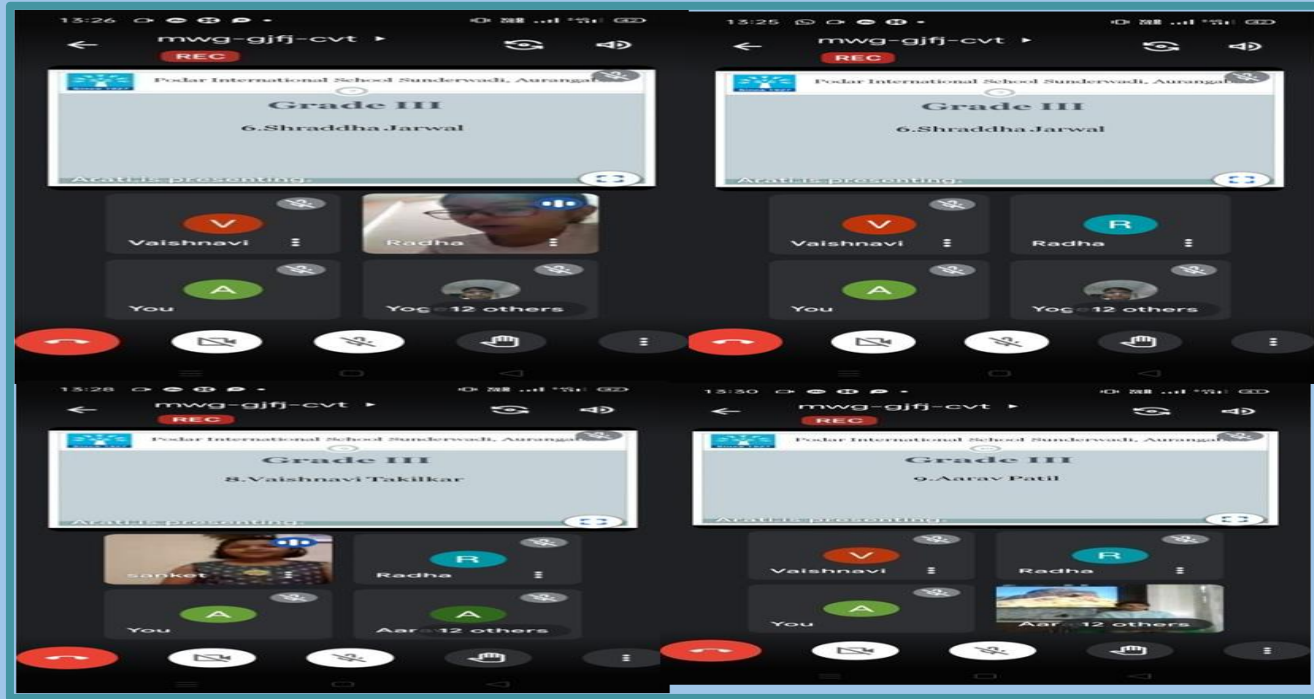

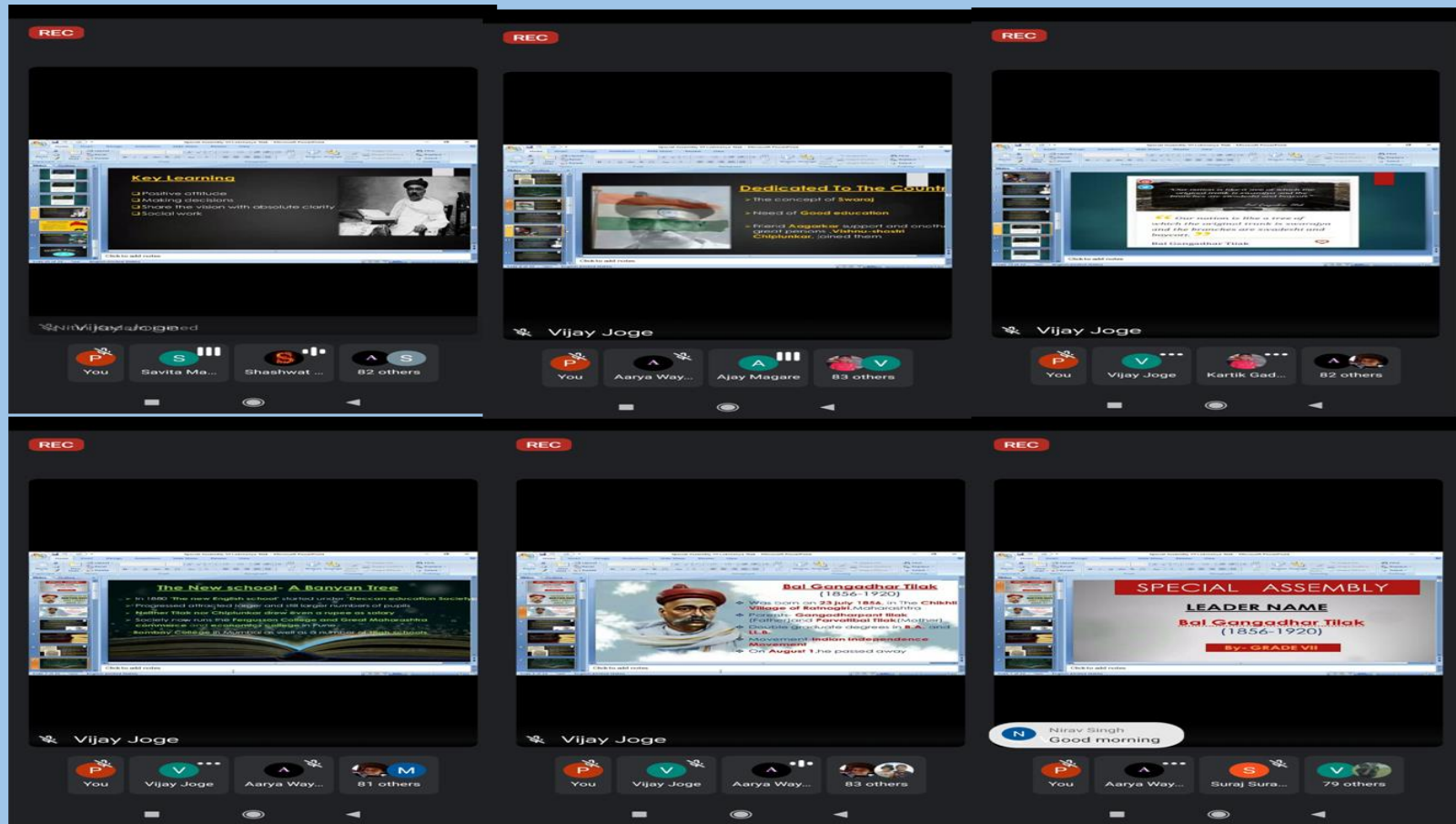

# Guru Pornima



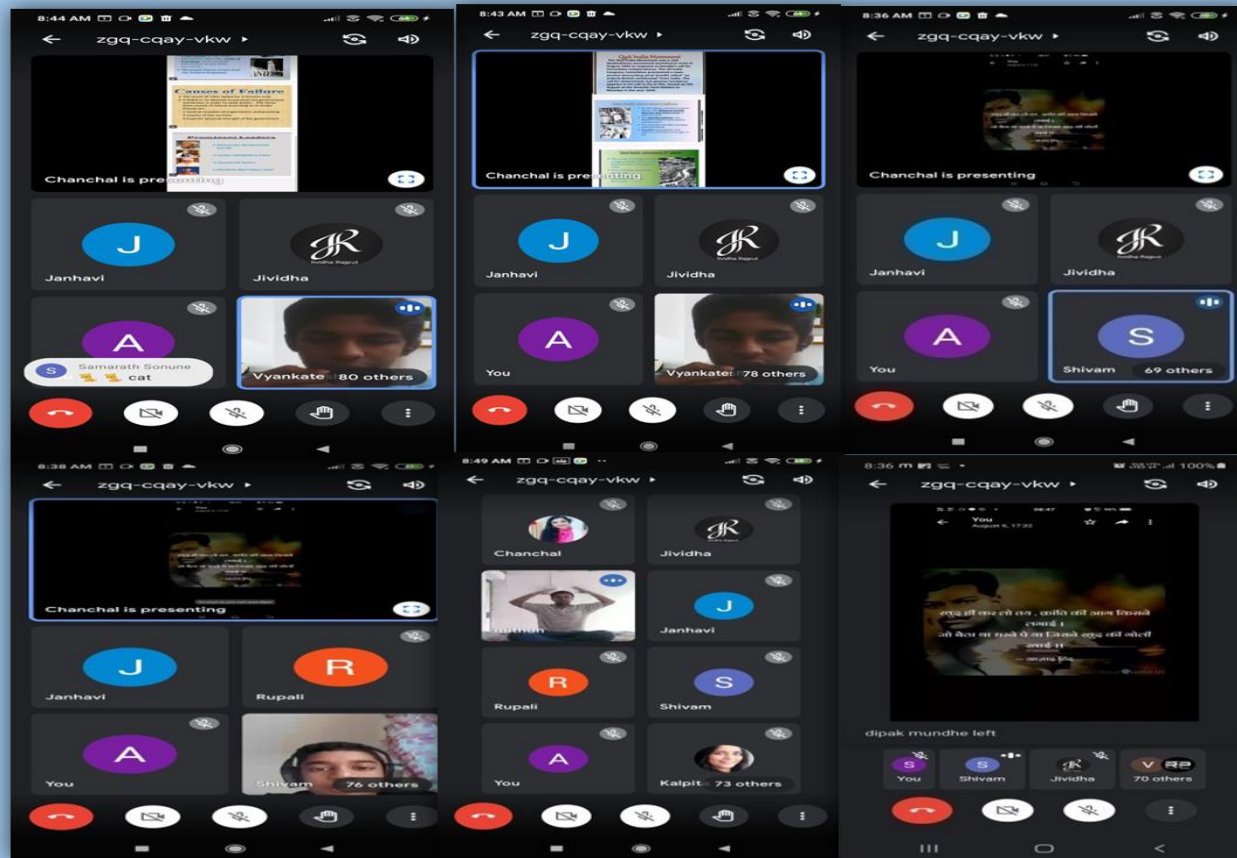

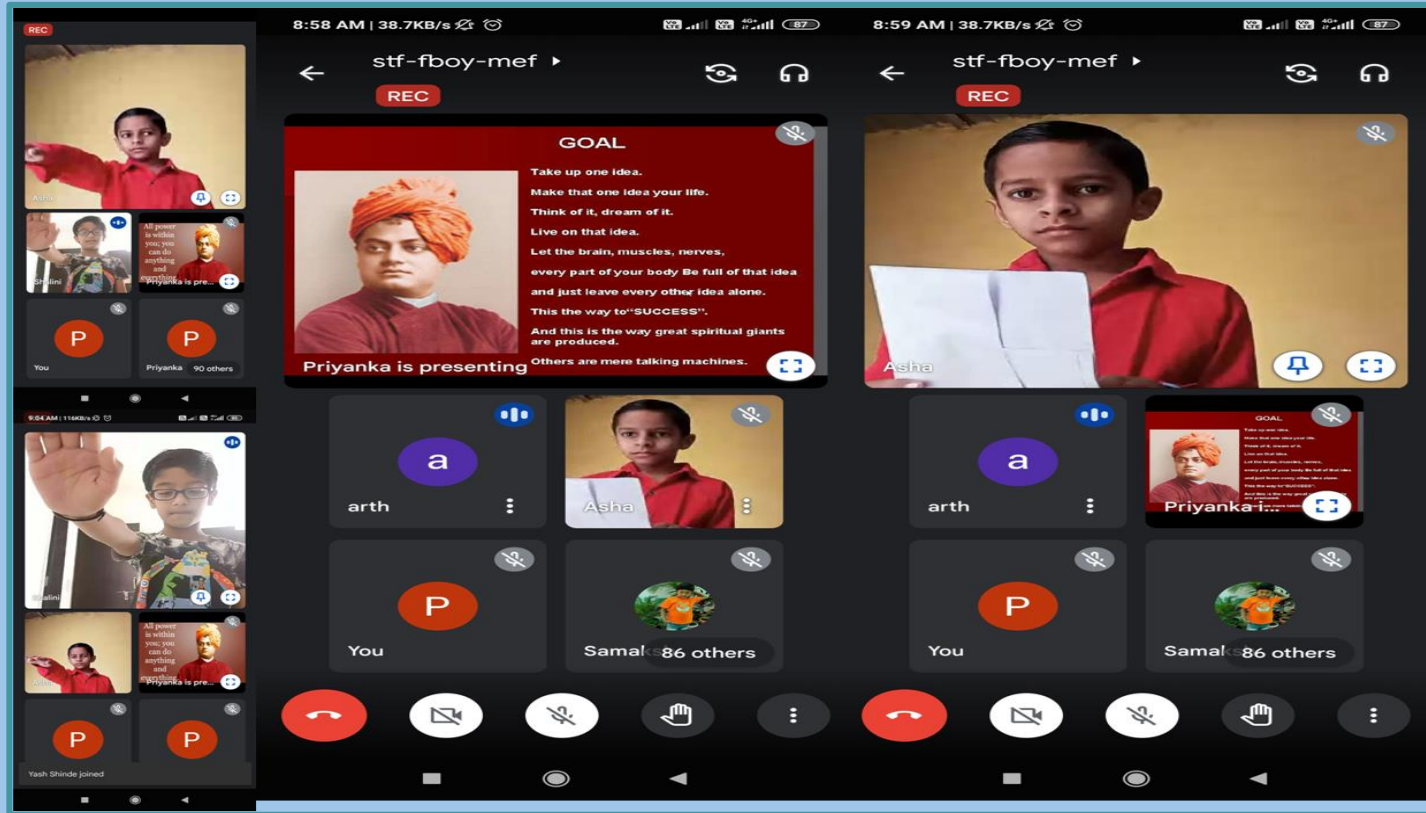
# Constitution Day

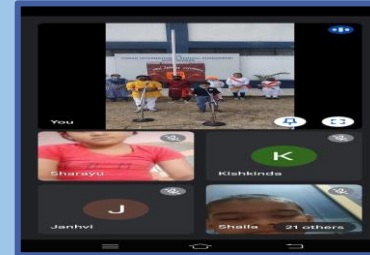
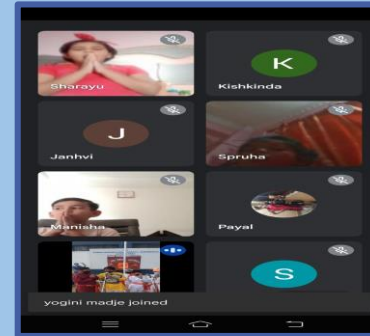
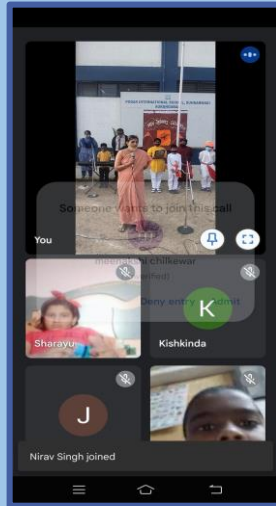


# Treasure Trove Club

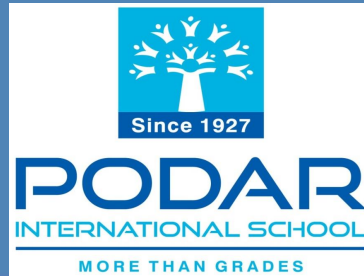
# Learning Outcomes Exhibition
