The overall and holistic development of our students we at PIS, Bhopal under the guidance of PODAR ENRICHMENT ACADEMY and our Principal Ma'am runs Hobby and Sports activities on Friday and Saturday for our students.

Under Hobby and Sports we conduct different activities which help our students to raise their self esteem, to learn time management, prioritize the things and release their stress.

Hobby-

Classical Dance - Dance keeps both the body and the brain active, vital for people of every age. It offers a way to improve strength and flexibility, which helps keeps muscles and joints healthy. It learn about your body , improving posture and balance.

Sports -

Cricket - In common with most sports there are health benefits for playing cricket. It can improve endurance, stamina, physical fitness and hand eye -coordination. Cricket also involves short bursts of sprinting and throwing which is good for cardio-vascular health. The game is good for developing team skills. It can help with social interaction and helps you to work with other people.

Football - Playing football provides numerous types of advantages, such as increased aerobic and anaerobic fitness, improved fitness skills and even psychosocial benefits. Football also suffices as a form of exercise that meets the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's minimum recommended exercise recommendations of 150 minutes per week. Football can benefit all ages, provided the participant's doctor approves, and his developmental stage, maturity and physical size suits a contact sport.

PT in regular Timetable - For the physical development of the student we arrange PT and Yoga lectures during their regular week schedule. This helps students for their overall development.

Art and Craft

Through creative art, children may be able to represent experiences that they cannot verbalize. They may draw pictures out of proportion, exaggerating things that are important to them. When we value children's creativity, we help them feel valued as people, raising their self-esteem. When child care providers offer art activities, they are supporting children's large and small muscle development, as well as their eye-hand coordination. Using crayons, markers, and paintbrushes helps children practice the fine motor control they will need for writing later on. When children work together in the art area, they learn to share, to interact with others, to be responsible for cleanup, and to put materials away. These are positive and important changes for social learning.

Young children can learn the names of colours and shapes through creative art activities. They find out what happens when they mix two primary colours together and get a secondary colour. Sending older children outside to carefully examine a tree, feel its bark, and study the shape and colour of its leaves, and then asking them to draw or paint trees helps them develop observational skills needed for science.

We at PIS Bhopal encourage the children to learn the foundational skills of art and craft express and communicate their ideas freely and think out of the box.

Its potential to nurture a positive school ethos that stresses care for the self, others and the pursuit of all forms of excellence should not be underestimated. It powerfully nurtures the development of intrapersonal intelligence.

Child safety is of utmost importance in today's time. The concept of 'good touch and bad touch' (GTBT) is still a hush-hush topic in households and classrooms. Most parents have a difficult time addressing this topic, but this doesn't mean that the topic can be avoided as well. Children must be educated on good touch (acceptable touch) and bad touch (inappropriate touch) invariably.

One may argue saying it is too early to broach the topic with a child, but children need to be told about this as they are too young to differentiate between what is right and what is wrong. Teaching them about GTBT will help them deal with a situation that seems abusive, in a better manner. The early the GTBT education, the safer it is for a child.

Podar International School conduct GTBT sessions in every month in which videos/ PPTs were also shown to students in order to maintain the good level of safety and security for each grade students so that every child to be aware of that their body belongs to them and they have a right to protect it. It is a great initiative and a step further to spread awareness about 'Good and Bad Touch' one of the most sensitive issues in today's time for children to understand the prevailing truth and essential guidelines to deal with the same, thus making themselves.





Symphonic

Symphonic is the in-house phonics program that in PIS spreads from Pre-school to Std. V. The program aims to develop a strong foundation in English language learning by integrating phonics into the learning of reading, writing and spelling of words.

The program incorporates the use of colorful flashcards, interesting stories and melodic rhymes for making learning joyful. The journey to reading is made easy and enjoyable with the help of read-along books which are in simple decodable text. Extensive lesson plans and illustrated teaching and behavior manuals support effective teaching.

Integrated English

An integrated learning program connects learning with real life situations and applies the learning from one situation to another.

Podar continues to provide a platform to display the creativity and trigger the innovative minds of its students. In view of this, the Integrated English Program designed by the Podar Innovation Centre aims at tapping the creative minds of the students and nurturing “out of the box” thinking skills in children. Integrated English classes are aimed at complementing learning through various themes planned, thus allowing children to think, invent, discover and explore their hidden potential. Yearly 4 themes are planned with, the theme for this session is: Mystical Rainforest, Space Trooper, Design a way &..... Wherein various activities are planned with under Jumpstart activity, Express yourself, House competition, Field trip, culminating event.



Thematic Learning

Podar has introduced Thematic learning for grade 1 & 2 students wherein our students got a concrete hands on exposure on concepts learning, this learning made our student understand better, and it is reflected in the better performance in the revision worksheet. 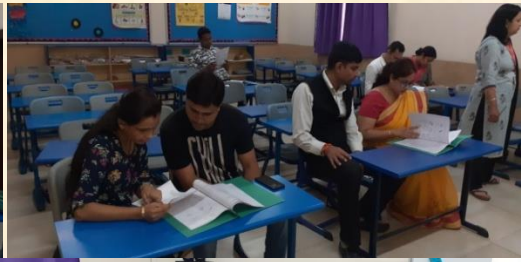
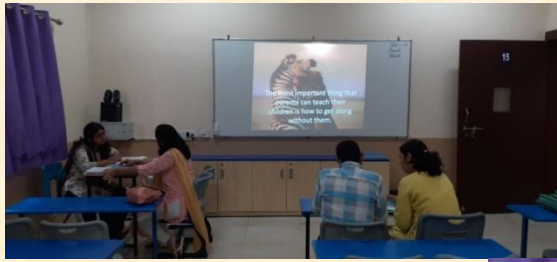

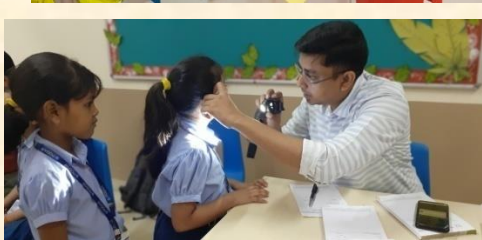
Open House meet

Annual Sports Meet

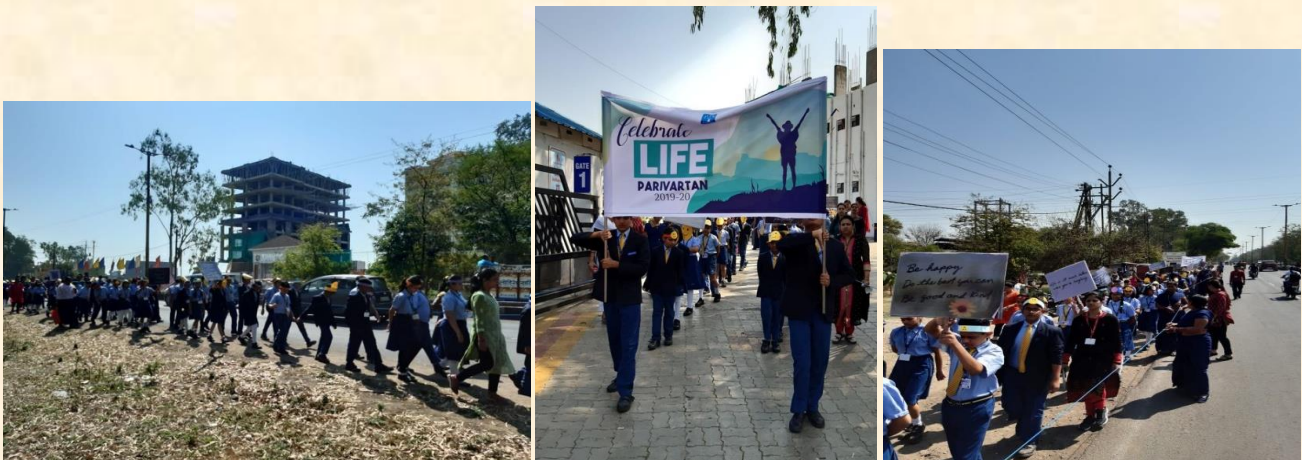

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PJK REPORT - 2019

Podar Jumbo Kids believes in a strong Teacher- Parent- Student partnership as it is a major contributor towards developing healthy and positive relationships, creating enabling environments which in turn supports learning and development in children.

Establishing a relationship with one's child's school is a two way process. It may so happen that not all parents can be involved in school as much as they would like but one can still be connected and let the child know that school is important in the family by talking about school and its related activities.

Parents need to create a supportive environment at home also for children – that values education. This will in turn help the child to become more independent, which will change the way you communicate with each other. Child will become more responsible and take more interest in school activities.

Parent- Teacher- Student is a shared responsibility and it is fruitful when parents and teachers listen and then respond to the desires and thoughts of the children but with respect. Communication across home and school, parents and teachers can help in making a significant change in the child's overall development and progress.

We would like to share the various ways we encourage and ensure Teacher – Parent and Student engagement at Podar Jumbo Kids all through the child's pre school years:-

(1) Playdate with Parents:

We organize 3 sessions in an academic session for Playdate with Parents, where Parents, Teachers and children are active participants and together we showcase the daily activities based on our unique curriculum. The parents come to know the daily schedule of the child in the school. This also helps the Parents become aware of the methods and techniques to be followed at home too.



(2) Portfolio Meets:

Portfolio meet is a Parent Teacher Meet where the child is always kept in the centre and is an integral part. It is held multiple times in a year to discuss about the progress of the child in all areas be it academics or non- academics. We ensure that the discussions are in a positive manner and child involvement is of utmost importance.

The facilitators, parents and the child all sit together, discussing the progress of the child. They then list down the points in agreement- giving ways and techniques which will help the child to achieve better results. The most important being that child has to agree to these suggestions.



(3) Student led Conference:

In this type of conference, the student becomes the teacher and showcases his/her progress in front of his/her Parents with the help of Portfolios maintained by their facilitator. The Teachers help and guide the children to discuss everything in a positive manner. It is expected from the Parents to be supporting, encouraging and motivating on their part. This exercise helps children to gain confidence to interact, enhance their vocabulary and develop leadership qualities.



(4) Events and Festivals:

It is important to hold social and cultural activities and festivals in the school as it helps preparing students for real life and strengthening their social and inter personal skills. Celebrating different festivals like Holi, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Christmas, Eid constitutes a community's cultural assests. Festival celebration will bring children close to their traditional roots and cultural beliefs. It helps build a strong bond between peer group as they understand each other's different customs.

We have all round the year many events like, Papa ko Chipko, Grandparents Day, Masterchef, Annual Concert, Annual Sports Day, etc. which showcases celebrating different cultures and diversity. The classrooms represent different backgrounds, cultures, language which are portrayed beautifully in the form of children's creativity and drawings.
