**Circular:** Corona virus COVID-19: Advisory

**Dear Parents,**

At the onset of this email, we would like to remind you that 'Panic causes tunnel vision', so let us remember to stay calm and stay informed.

The School will follow all Government Advisories & Guidelines with regards to precautionary holidays and will keep our parents informed in a timely fashion.

As we are all aware the virus (COVID-19) is contagious, so here is a list of small precautionary measures that we request you to follow and also reiterate the same with children. We will also as always, remind them of the importance of following hygiene practices that help in preventing such diseases.

## **Essential Steps shared by the World Health Organisation :**

**Wash your hands frequently:** Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash them with soap and water.

**Maintain social distancing:** Maintain at least 1 metre (3 feet) distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.

**Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth:** Hands touch many surfaces and can pick up viruses. Once contaminated, hands can transfer the virus to your eyes, nose or mouth.

**Practice respiratory hygiene:** Make sure you, and the people around you, follow good respiratory hygiene. This means covering your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze.

**If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical care early:** Stay home if you feel unwell. If you have a fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical attention and call in advance.

**Stay informed and follow advice given by your healthcare provider:** Stay informed on the latest developments about COVID-19. National and local authorities will have the most up to date information on whether COVID-19 is spreading in your area.

**It is also recommended that travelling outside the country or to crowded places unless it is unavoidable, be kept to the minimum.**
