

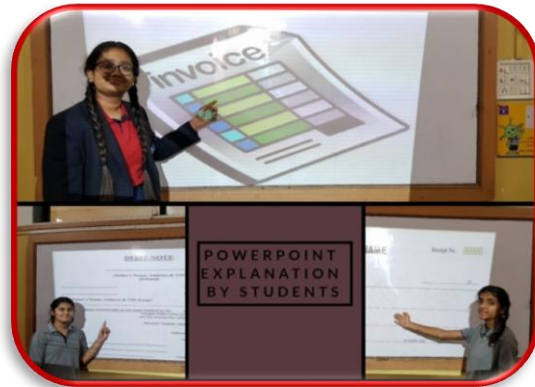
Podar International School Cambridge International, Kalyan International School Award: Activity 7 “BUSINESS DOCUMENTS”
