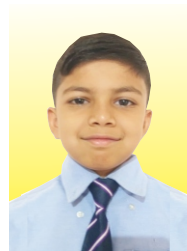
Podar Spellers bagged National Second Rank @ Spellathon

The Spoken English and Computer Course for Parents



In order to create a sense of confidence and awareness about the need of Spoken English and Computer fundamentals in the fast moving global era, Podar International School Baramati has arranged Certificate Course for English communication and Fundamentals of Computer for parents.

The specially designed modules for the spoken English includes activity based 45 sessions. It also covers many language games such as dumb charades, my pumpkin, face it, tom dick and harry etc. Different vocabulary games, activities on functional grammar has been included in the modules. The spoken English sessions have been arranged thrice a

week for one and half hour before the school gets over. The prime motif behind the initiative is to encourage the parental involvement in the teaching learning process. A large number of parents feel helpless while cross-checking class-work and home-work of their wards many a occasions.

Along with Spoken English, school has also initiated a basic computer course for 45 sessions. It has also been planned for every alternate days in the week. It has included the introduction of computer hardware, software, the functioning of different components of computer. 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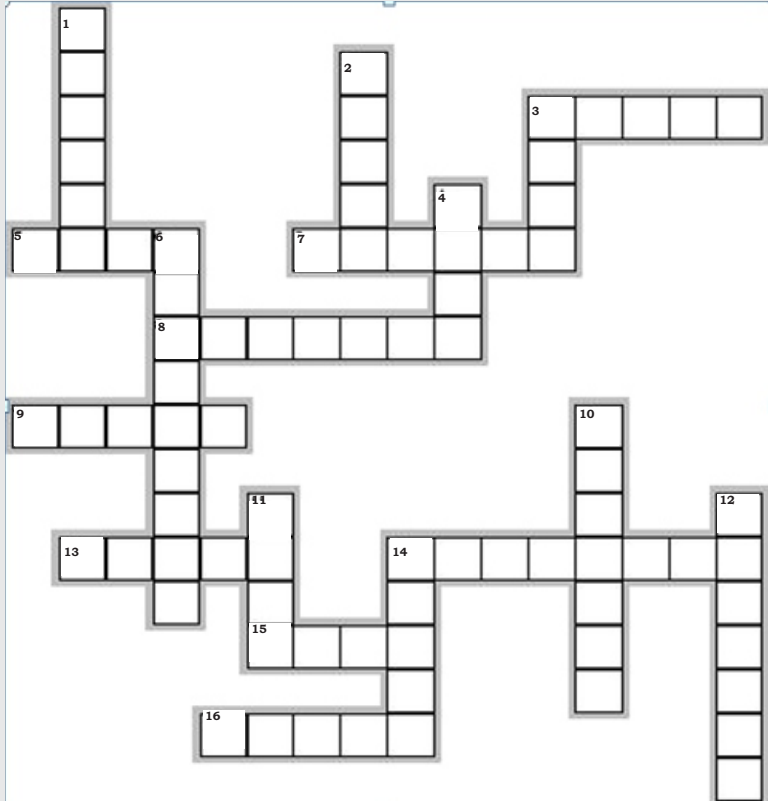

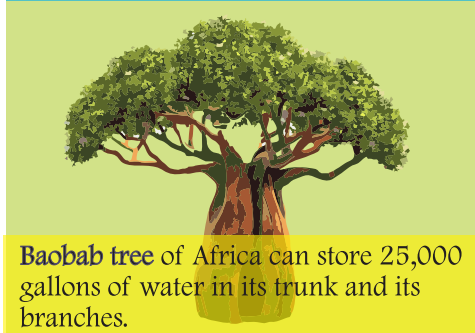
