

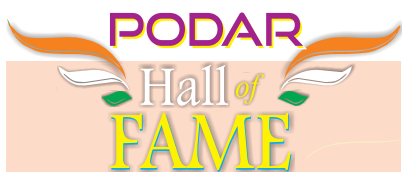

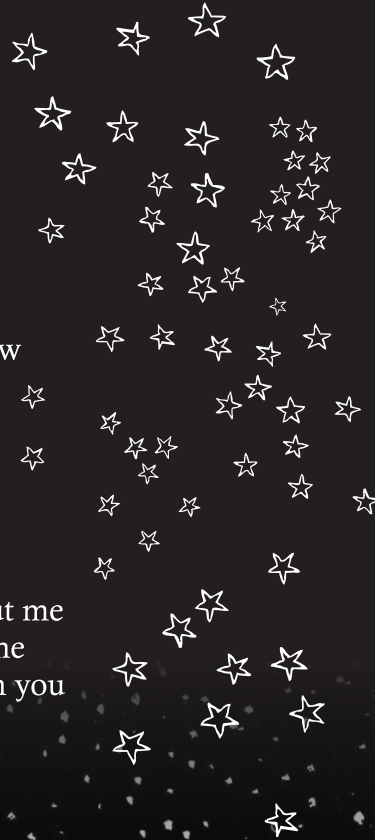


## Punctuality

 Can hold me back

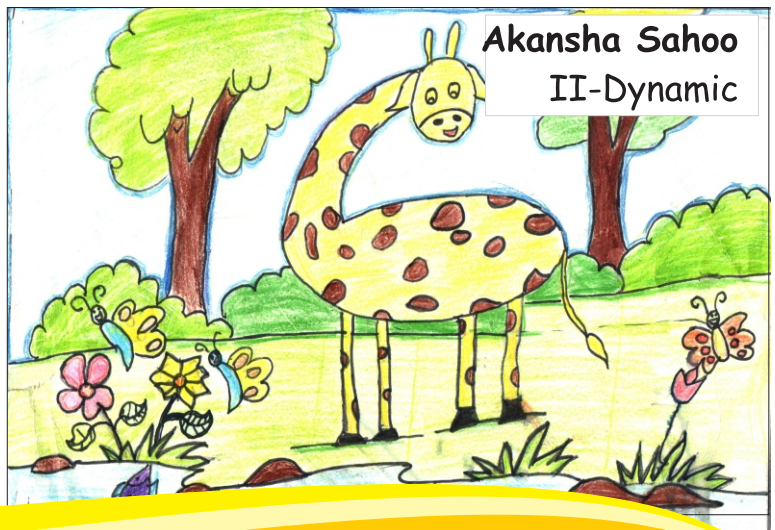

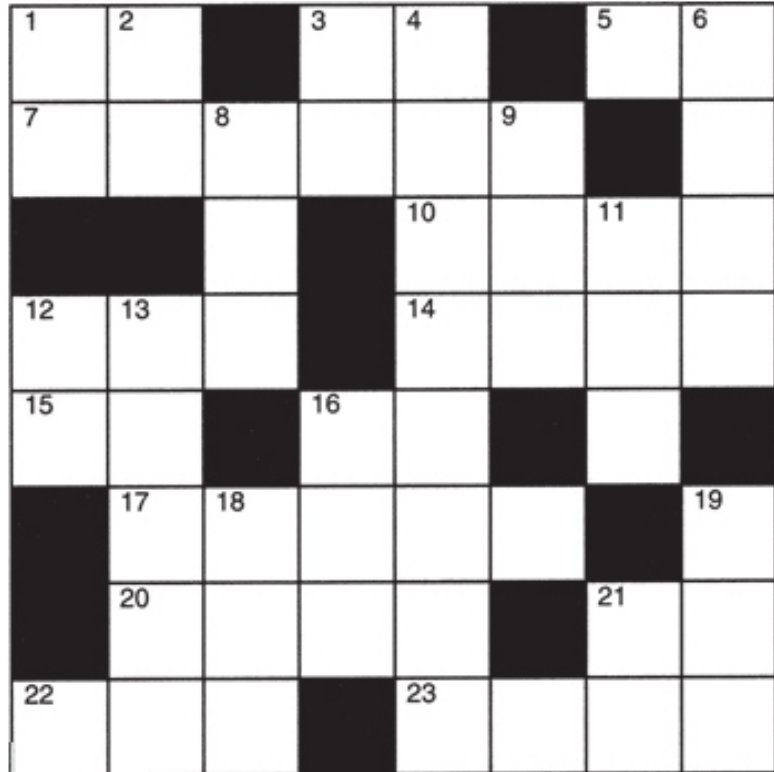


