The yearly updates of activities where the school takes the modesty to say that we did our best to do as we had planned and we are proud of our students and teachers who strive hard to achieve beyond expectations. We have focused on the holistic development of the students, fostering 21st Century skill to make our students future ready. It gives us pleasure to announce our first Batch result of Grade XII Science and Humanities where Ms Tithi Gohil scored 93% in Science and Ms Srushti Thakre scored 93.6% in Humanities and Fourth pass out batch of Grade X where we have achieved 100% pass result. Mas Sanchit Bhushan scored 98.6%.

The first day of the school began with the first theme of Integrated English **Tech it Up!-A world of Gadgets and Gizmos**. A special assembly on National Technology Day was celebrated. The students got an opportunity to interact with Medical Lab Technologist. A House competition '**Tech Revolution 2050**' was organized which prompted students to look for and become aware of predictions about the future in various fields like artificial intelligence, communication and computing. The students visited an electronic store too. The culminating event '**Tech O Mania**' exposed them to a technical knowledge of machines and gadgets.

The second theme of the year was **Young Entrepreneur-Discovering the businessman in you**. A special talk show was organized to mark World Entrepreneurs Day. The students got an opportunity to talk with a woman entrepreneur from Gujarat. An interesting House competition **Pitch it! The clash of Advertisements** gave the students an idea how to sell the product, how to use mass media for marketing techniques to promote business etc. The students visited Supermarket and Axis Bank under this theme. The theme culminated into **Bizkids bazaar** which provided an opportunity to use business management skills.

The third theme of the year was **Mythbusters-uncovering Myths, fairy tales and legends engraved in time**. A special assembly Halloween was conducted. The students interacted with a Historian under Expert Talk. The students got an opportunity to think, explore and express their learning in a creative way through House competition-**The Wall of Myth**'. The students visited Sanskritik Kendra-Ramayana Cultural Center Koradi as a part of field trip. The event culminated with 'Believe it or not'.

The last and the ongoing theme of the year is **Significant People- Character and Events that changed the world**. A talk show on Greta Thunberg was conducted as a special assembly. The students got an opportunity to talk with a community hero and visited an orphanage as a part of field trip. House competition and culminating event '**Parivartan Drive**' will be conducted towards the end of this month.

A two days special feature '**Celebrating Kabir**' and **International Year of Millets 2023** was a great learning for the students. This year the school offered Five Clubs in Term I namely **The Gourmet club, Green Wizard club, Music and More club, Treasure trove club and the Drama club**. The Annual events like International Yoga DAY, Investiture ceremony, Independence day, Hindi diwas, Ganesh chaturthi, Navratri, Diwali celebration, Sports day, Teachers day, Children's Day, Christmas celebration, Republic day and Vasant panchami made this year enthusiastic and joyful for the students.

Thematic Learning, a teaching through a module which is often interdisciplinary. It is the way of teaching and learning where many areas of the curriculum are connected together and integrated within the theme.

The first thematic unit for grade I was '**Marvellous Me**' got culminated into '**Celebrating Me**'. It was followed by '**Look where we live**' which got culminated in 'Won't you be our neighbour'? Next unit was '**Nature Trails**' which ended with 'Jungle Beats'.

Thematic Unit for Grade II began with '**In my Town**' which culminated with an event 'Welcome to our Town'. Next unit was '**What we wear**' which ended in 'Fashion Fiesta'. The ongoing theme for grade II is **Let's take a trip**.

Not only Academics, the school also provides platform to students to participate in various interschool competition and Olympiads. The students participated in Spell bee competition and bagged gold medals, participated in Sanskrit drama competition organized by Kavikulguru Kalidas Sanskrit Vishwavidhyalaya Ramtek, bagged medals and trophies in international level of Art competition, Ms Abdhija santra of grade IX bagged Gold medal in international Social studies Olympiad, students also brought laurels in Master Art competition, state level Art competition organized by Kalasparsh, National level Art competitions held by Rangotsav celebration Mumbai. These students are now selected for International Art competition.

The students bagged third prize in Best Drama production and Ms Shreyasi pargaonkar was awarded for Best Acting female in Baldarbar – mega children's drama festival and in Vidarbha Balnatya Spardha at Wardha.

The students bagged Gold medal of Excellence and merit certificate in IEO, IGKO and NSO Olympiads. Read and Grow competition, 3D Printing Showcase of 3D Models were the other achievements of this year.

Ms Gauri Trehan, and Vaishnavi Bedwal bagged Silver and bronze medal in 31st Junior State Fencing championship. The students brought trophy in 4th open interschool Yogasana championship, participated in 13th Vincent palloti memorial Nagpur district interschool chess championship, Mas darsh bhisikar brought laurel in Interschool karate championship, medals bagged by Vaishnavi Bedwal in Divisional level interschool fencing competition and under 14, state level fencing competition. Mas vidhan singh bagged gold medal in 2nd state level karate championship.

Interschool State level fencing competition, Lokmat maha games fencing competition, Nagpur district level fencing championship, 24th Nagpur District SQAY Championship, District level Archery competition etc.
