


Women's Equality means rights of equality in decision making, economic and social freedom, equal access to education and right to practise an occupation of one's choice. The women were given these rights in 1950.

Raksha Bandhan

Raksha Bandhan is a Hindu festival, most commonly celebrated in South Asia. The word "Raksha Bandhan" originated from Sanskrit which literally means bond of protection, care, or obligation. On this day, sisters of all ages tie an amulet or thread around the wrist of their brothers,

6) Once in a blue moon.


Meaning: To do something "once in a blue moon" is to do it very rarely. **Sentence:** "That company puts on a good performance only once in a blue moon."

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संस्कृत दिवस

भारत में हर साल श्रावणी पूर्णिमा के शुभ अवसर को संस्कृत दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है। हमारी संस्कृति में संस्कृत भाषा के प्राचीनतम भाषा होने की वजह से यह दिन मनाया जाता है। संस्कृत लगभग सभी वेदों और पुराणों की भाषा है। इसलिए लोगों में संस्कृत भाषा के प्रति सम्मान है। हमारे धार्मिक ग्रंथों और मन्त्रों का वर्णन अधिकतर इसी भाषा में मिलता है। संस्कृत दिवस अपने आप में बहुत अनूठा है, क्योंकि राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर किसी भी अन्य प्राचीन भाषा में इस तरह से उत्सव नहीं मनाया जाता है।





भाव रखा जाता है और हमारे ऋषि-मुनि संस्कृत साहित्य के मूल स्रोत हैं, इसलिए श्रावणी पूर्णिमा को संस्कृत दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है और इसे ऋषि पर्व के रूप में भी मनाया जाता है।

इस दिन भारत सरकार के शिक्षा मंत्रालय के आदेश से वर्ष 1969 में केन्द्रीय एवं राज्य स्तर पर संस्कृत दिवस मनाने का निर्देश जारी किया गया था। तभी से



श्रावण की पूर्णिमा के दिन पूरे भारत में संस्कृत दिवस मनाया जाता है। इसके लिए श्रावण पूर्णिमा के दिन को चुनने का कारण यह है कि हमारे प्राचीन भारत में इस दिन से ही शिक्षण सत्र और वेद पाठ शुरू हुआ था और छात्र भी इसी दिन से शास्त्रों का अध्ययन करने लगे थे। संस्कृत दिवस और संस्कृत सप्ताह मनाने का मूल उद्देश्य संस्कृत भाषा का प्रचार-प्रसार करना है। संस्कृत दिवस 31 अगस्त 2023 को मनाया जाएगा।


विश्व फोटोग्राफी दिवस

फ्रांस के जोसेफ नाइसफोर और लुइस डॉगेर ने फोटोग्राफी का आविष्कार किया था. इसके बाद 19 अगस्त, 1839 को फ्रांस की सरकार ने इस आविष्कार की घोषणा की और उसका पेटेंट हासिल किया. यही वो दिन है, जिसे हमेशा याद रखने के लिए हर साल 19 अगस्त को 'वर्ल्ड फोटोग्राफी डे' यानी 'विश्व फोटोग्राफी दिवस' मनाया जाता है.फोटोग्राफी एक कला है जो उन चित्रों को बनाती है जो एक बार जीवन में देखे जाने वाले अनुभवों को यादगार बनाते हैं। यह एक ऐसा

हैं। फोटोग्राफी का कोर्स करने के लिए बारहवी (12th) पास होना अनिवार्य है। जहां फाइन आर्ट्स विषयों में इसे एक ऑप्शनल बैचलर्स डिग्री के रूप में ऑफर किया जाता है। वही कुछ कॉलेज इसे डिग्री कोर्स के साथ पार्ट टाइम कोर्स के रूप में भी प्रस्तुत करते हैं। भारत के मशहूर फोटोग्राफर रघुनाथ राय चौधरी, रघु राय के नाम से चर्चित हैं. वह पूरी दुनिया में फोटोग्राफी की दुनिया का जीवंत नाम हैं. रघु राय

महान फोटोग्राफर हेनरी कार्टियर ब्रेसन के शिष्य थे.

भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन दिवस / अगस्त क्रांति दिन

9 अगस्त 1942 को राष्ट्रपिता महात्मा गांधी जी के नेतृत्व में 'भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन' आरंभ हुआ था। इसके प्रतीक स्वरूप 'अगस्त क्रांति दिवस' पर भारतीय स्वतंत्रता के लिए अपने प्राणों की आहुति देने वाले सभी अमर शहीदों को शत शत नमन करता हूँ।हर साल 8 अगस्त को भारतीय इतिहास में आजादी की आखिरी लड़ाई की शुरुआत के रूप में याद किया जाता है। इसी दिन 1942 में महात्मा गांधी द्वारा चलाए गए भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन (Quit India Movement) की नींव

रखी गई थी। आजादी के बाद से, 8 अगस्त को क्रांति दिवस के रूप में जाना जाता है और बॉम्बे में जहां इसे झंडा फहराकर शुरू किया गया था, उसे क्रांति मैदान के रूप में जाना जाता है। भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन की शुरुआत 08 अगस्त 1942 को हुई थी। इस आंदोलन का नेतृत्व राष्ट्रपिता महात्मा गांधी ने किया था।

महात्मा गांधी ने 08 अगस्त 1942 को अखिल भारतीय कांग्रेस कमेटी (AICC) के बॉम्बे (अब मुंबई) अधिवेशन में इसकी शुरुआत की थी। भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन अंग्रेजी हुकूमत के खिलाफ काफी प्रभावशाली साबित हुआ और शासन की नींद उड़ गई थी।भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन का प्राथमिक उद्देश्य ब्रिटिश औपनिवेशिक शासन से तत्काल और पूर्ण स्वतंत्रता

प्राप्त करना था। इसमें भारत पर से अंग्रेजों का नियंत्रण समाप्त कर एक संप्रभु एवं स्वशासित राष्ट्र की स्थापना करने की मांग की गई।भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन का भारत के स्वतंत्रता संग्राम पर महत्वपूर्ण प्रभाव पड़ा। यह अहिंसक प्रतिरोध की शक्ति का प्रतिनिधित्व करता था और सभी पृष्ठभूमियों के एकजुट लोग स्वतंत्रता के लिए एक साथ खड़े थे। कठोर दमन के बावजूद, आंदोलन ने



स्व-शासन की मांग को हवा दी और ब्रिटिश सरकार को भारतीय नेताओं के साथ बातचीत करने के लिए मजबूर किया।भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन ने एक स्थायी विरासत छोड़ी जिसने दिखाया कि अहिंसक विरोध और एकता कैसे बड़े बदलाव ला सकते हैं। इस आंदोलन ने 15 अगस्त, 1947 को स्वतंत्रता प्राप्ति में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभाई।भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन को अगस्त क्रांति के नाम के नाम से भा जाना जाता है। इस आंदोलन की शुरुआत आठ अगस्त को हुई थी, लेकिन आमतौर पर लोगों का मानना है कि इसकी शुरुआत नौ अगस्त को हुई थी। इस आंदोलन के दौरान 14 हजार से अधिक लोगों को जेल में डाल दिया गया था।



अनेक खाद्यपदार्थही तयार केले जातात. केरळ राज्यातील सर्वच जाती-धर्माचे लोक हा उत्सव मोठ्या आनंदात साजरा करतात.

या सणासाठी केरळात घरांना रंग देऊन दर्शनी भाग फुलांनी शृंगारतात. गृहिणी घरापुढचे अंगण सारवतात व त्यावर बहुरंगी रांगोळी काढतात. गावात व रानात हिंडून फुले गोळा करणे हे मुलांचे



काम असते. दहा दिवसपर्यंत अशी पुष्पशोभा केल्यावर श्रवण नक्षत्राच्या मुख्य दिवशी वामनाची मृण्मय मूर्ती करून ता अंगणात बसवितात व त्याभोवती पुष्पशोभा करतात. प्रथम सर्व मिळून "आरप्पू" असा उद्घोष करतात. त्यानंतर वामनाची पूजा करतात. उत्सवाच्या निमित्ताने केरळचे पारंपरिक नृत्य कथकली आणि पुलीकली किंवा काडुवकलीचे आयोजन ठिकठिकाणी केले जाते. ओनसद्या या पक्वान्नाशिवाय ओणमची सांगता होत नाही. तसेच तांदूळ आणि तांदळाचे विविध पदार्थ, डाळीची आमटी, पापड आणि तूप असा जेवणाचा बेत असतो. सांबार, ओलण, रसम, थोरन, अवियल, पचडी, विविध प्रकारची लोणची आणि मोरू (ताक) यांनाही फार महत्त्व आहे.

तीर्थयात्रेला गेलेला अर्जुन कन्याकुमारीहून इंद्रप्रस्थाला निघाला. त्याच्याजवळ कृष्णाची मूर्ती होती. तो पंपा नदीकाठी येतो. पंपा नदीला पूर आलेला असल्याने नौका बंद असतात. एक नाविक आपली नौका घेऊन धाडसाने पुढे येतो आणि अर्जुनाला पैलतीरी नेतो. नदी पार झाल्यावर अर्जुनाने त्या तीरावर आपल्याकडील कृष्णाची म्हणजे पार्थ सारथीची मूर्ती स्थापन केली. कालांतराने तेथे मंदिर उभारले गेले. या घटनेच्या स्मरणार्थ प्रतिवार्षिक नौका उत्सव सुरू झाला असे मानले जाते. ओणमच्या वेळी पारंपरिक सर्प नौका स्पर्धांचे आयोजन दरवर्षी ऑगस्ट महिन्याच्या दुसऱ्या शनिवारी केले जाते. या स्पर्धेच्या खास नौका फणसाच्या लाकडाच्याच बनविलेल्या असतात. त्या खूप लांब आणि निमुळत्या असतात, एकेका नौकेत शंभरावर लोकही असतात. त्यात नौका वल्हविणाऱ्यांसह मोठ्या आवाजात साद घालून उत्साह वाढविणारेही असतात. नौका वल्हवणारे नावाडी शुभ्र वस्त्रे आणि शुभ्र शिरोवेष्टन वापरतात.

या दिवशी घरातील नोकर माणसांना नवी वस्त्रे दिली जातात. या दिवशी चेंडूचा एक विशिष्ट खेळ खेळला जातो, त्याला "नाटन " असे नाव आहे. या दिवसात स्त्रिया व मुली रात्री एकत्र खेळ खेळतात त्याला "कैकोटीवकळी" म्हणतात.

आंतराष्ट्रीय युवा दिन

कोणत्याही देशासाठी तरुणांचा सहभाग सर्वात महत्त्वाचा असतो. विकसित आणि विकसनशील अशा दोन्ही देशांतील तरुणांना मानसिक आणि सामाजिक अडचणी येण्याची शक्यता जास्त असते. म्हणूनच तरुणांनी जागरूक आणि विविध आव्हानांचा सामना करण्यास सक्षम असणे अत्यंत आवश्यक आहे. दरवर्षी १२ ऑगस्ट हा दिवस 'आंतरराष्ट्रीय युवा दिन' म्हणून तरुणांमध्ये कायदेशीर समस्या आणि त्यांच्या सांस्कृतीविषयी जागरुकता निर्माण करण्यासाठी साजरा केला जातो.

Nail art


